Block-A-Month Quilting Class

Even if you've never done much sewing, you can learn to quilt!

- Create a beautiful new block each month.
- Assemble a sampler quilt from a variety of blocks.

You will start with the easiest block and learn a new skill each class. This is the class for you if you've always loved the look and feel of a homemade quilt and want to sew an heirloom of your own.

The first class will teach you how to choose the right fabrics and amounts, preshrinking and ironing, use of the rotary cutter and mats, and how to cut and piece the first block. You'll need to bring a notebook and writing utensil, and if you already own them, a cutting board, quilting ruler and rotary cutter. Sewing machines, cutting mats and rotary cutters, iron and ironing board, and fabric for the first night to "practice" on will be provided.
